RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The scholarships are limited to members who have been in good standing for at least one-year as of April 15th and their unmarried children or dependents under the age of 20.
2. The scholarship winners will be selected and awards made on the basis of community involvement and completion of an essay, which shows understanding of the principles of the labor movement (no more than 250 words, typed). In reviewing the scholarship application, consideration may be given to geographic distribution of the scholarships.
3. The UFCW Local 496 Scholarship Application must be postmarked no later than April 16, 2012.
4. Scholarship winners will receive one award of \$500.00 payable to the school offering a qualified course of study (barber, barber apprentice, cosmetologist, nail tech, esthetician, etc.)
5. The fiscal year for the scholarship awards are from May 1 – April 30. Awards will be forfeited if not used by the end of the fiscal period.
6. The scholarship committee will have the full discretion to make the final decisions concerning the number of scholarships awarded each year, and the winners of each of the scholarships. All scholarship awards are final.
